On behalf of the Knoxville Track Club, Eagle Distributing Company, and the City of Knoxville, I'd like to thank you for running in this the 14th annual running of a Knoxville tradition. Many traditions are worth hanging onto; your increased participation (1819 runners) this year lends substance to this. EXPO is also a tradition of innovations. This year, we had a new sponsor with Bud Light, a new bicentennial course, new craft awards, a new centipede division, more refreshments and vendors for the post race party. Despite an early May date, the temperature at race time was a humid 71 degrees. The winners of the new pledge division for the trip to Mexico, the all terrain bike, and hiking and backpacking gear will not be announced until June 1 when all pledges are to be turned in.

Some interesting figures follow: T-shirt sizes: 81 small, 256 medium, 792 large, 689 x-large. Of the 1819 registrants, 388 were KTC members. Thirteen states were represented. Six % came from out-of state, almost half of these from Georgia. The top three were TN with 1707 runners, Ga with 51, and Ky with 26. The top three towns were Knoxville with 1054 runners, Oak Ridge with 104, and Maryville with 55. Approximately 70% were male, 30% female. Age group breakdowns are as follows:

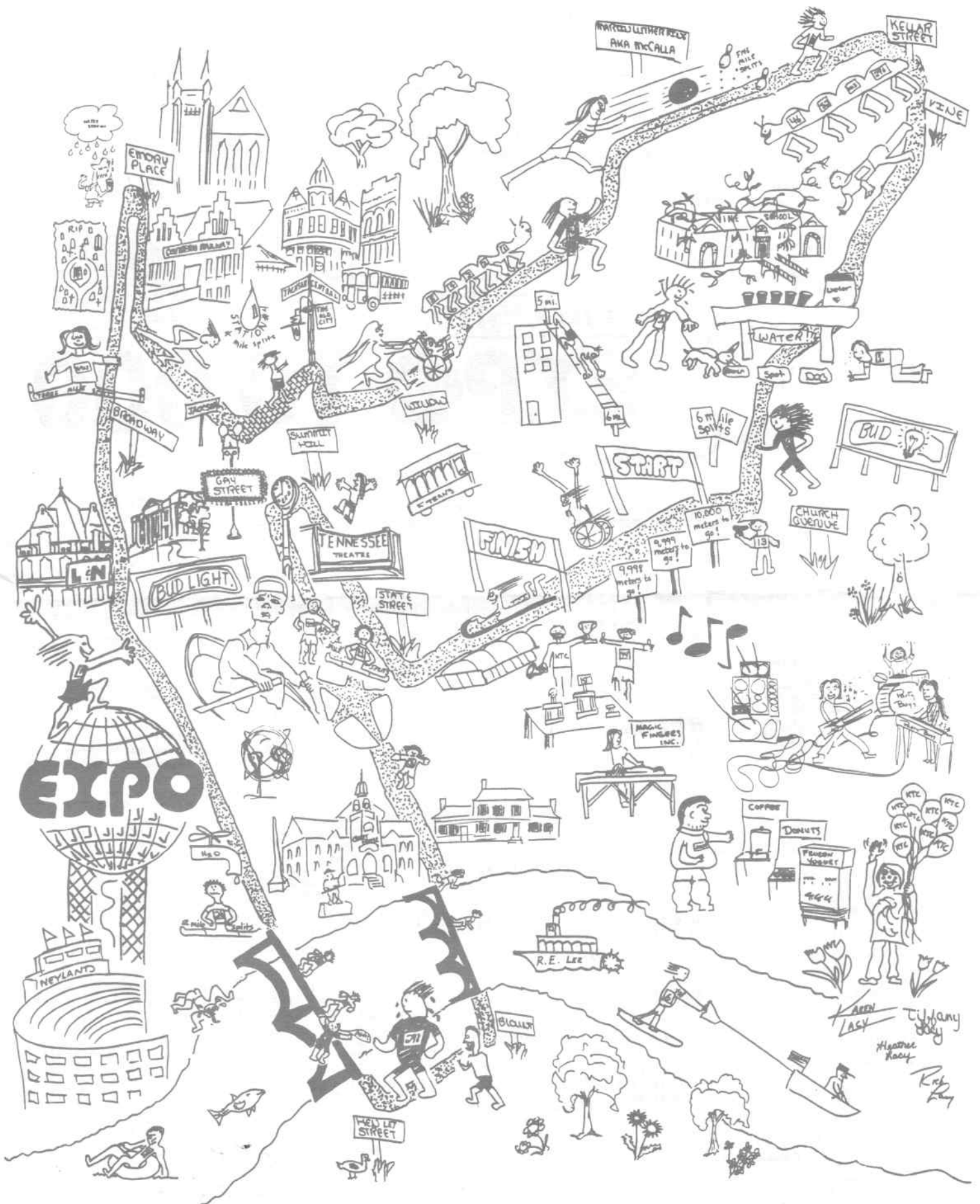
